Introduction/Focus Activity:	The teacher will turn on the projector and computer, and upload the	5min
	PowerPoint presentation "I Entered a Wonderland." Next the teacher will	
	arrange 6 groups of 4-5 students for a later activity.	
Delivery of Content:	The teacher will go through the PowerPoint "I Entered a Wonderland," with	10min
	the class listening to the presentation. Additionally, the teacher will stop to	
	match words with the pictures on the PowerPoint.	
	The teacher will go through the presentation a second time with the class choral reading the story.	
	The teacher will explain the directions for the class assignment—writing,	
	illustrating, and presenting a short story based on the reading:	
	-There will be 6 groups of 4-5 students.	
	-Each student has one of the following roles: drawer #1, drawer #2, drawer #3	
	(these students will illustrate 3 drawings based on the story "I Entered a	

	Wonderland"), writer (this student will write a different ending to the story), reader/ helper to the writer (this student will read the new story ending to the class) -At the end of the class, students will present their short story to their classmates. Next, the teacher will go over the teacher-made example of what the short story should look like.	
Guided Practice:	Students will collaborate and complete the short story assignment. The teacher will go around the classroom assisting students with the assignment.	20min
Independent Practice:	Students will present their short story to the class.	10min
Closure:	If time, the class will go back over the story "I Entered a Wonderland," in order to practice fluency.
