STAGE 3 – LEARNING PLAN AND LEARNING TASKS	INSTRUCTIONAL STRATEGIES:	MIN.
Introduction/Focus Activity:	The teacher will hand out the irregular verb worksheet. Students will quietly change the irregular verbs into past tense. The teacher will go around the classroom and check answers. The teacher will also select students to put the verbs into past tense on the board.	10min
Delivery of Content:	As a class, we will go over the irregular past tense verbs.Next, we will go over how to ask questions with "did." As a class we will go over how to ask questions for the Human Scavenger Hunt activity. The teacher will write the questions on the board. Students will copy the questions on their worksheet. Students will also make up two of their own questions for the human scavenger hunt.	
	<ul> <li>The teacher will explain the rules of the human scavenger hunt.</li> <li>1. Students will go around and ask their classmates questions from the human scavenger hunt worksheet.</li> <li>2. Students must ask eight different students.</li> <li>3. If the student answers "yes" to the question they will sign the worksheet.</li> <li>4. Students must receive eight different signatures, including one signature from the teacher.</li> <li>5. Students will return to their seats after they have received eight different signatures.</li> </ul>

	If there is extra time, students must receive an additional eight signatures from different classmates.
